The basic outline

DAY 1: 22nd. November 2018

- Presentation and interactive debate on the understanding of migration mobility patterns for the Security law policymaking and strategies to facilitate orderly, safe, regular and responsible migration and mobility as foreseen in the Sustainable Development Goals of Agenda 2030; further presentations and discussion on the international protection of refugees; private and public law.
- Exchange of international and national experiences on the security and legal effects of migration in the Europe, in the protection of Schengen borders; further presentations and discussion on the future development of asylum policies and their implementation within the EU; the integration policies challenge; private and public law.

DAY 2: 23rd November 2018

- Bilateral discussions of section participants on the selected praxeological problems of managing migration
- Processing a report from a professional discussion in the project section for the principal researcher of the University of Siena, Italy.
